What are the missions of the CRA?

Under the supervision of our International Marketing Director, your main mission is to manage (set up and monitor) the clinical and economic studies and process the data from these studies.

Your main tasks are :

- Validate the study plan with the competent authorities.
- Write scientific / clinical protocols.
- Select the investigators for the studies related to the project, the research centers and train the doctors and the medical staff (teaching aids ...).
- Carry out the monitoring visits of the investigating centers (regular quality controls) / remote monitoring, follow-up of inclusions and control of studies, if necessary.
- Monitor adverse events related to Materiovigilance
- Enter the clinical data collected where appropriate.
- Process data from clinical studies, control consistency and quality of clinical project data.
- Interpret and homogenize the results of studies.
- Write reports and publications of study results.
- In connection with the Regulatory Affairs Department: lead the Clinical Evaluation reports as part of the CE marking
- Follow the Post Market Clinical Follow up

What is the profile we require?

- You have a scientific background at Master level (in biology, medicine, pharmacy), and you a significant experience allowing you to work autonomously in the position
- You master the methods of research and bibliographic analysis, clinical research methods as well as the Regulation applicable to Medical Devices in an international context.
- You are comfortable with project management, you know how to define priorities for action and the allocation of resources / deadlines.
- Friendly, with good communication skills, you are also organized and rigorous.
- You speak English fluently, German is a plus.
